RESOLUTION FOR PROHIBITING SEMI-TRUCK VEHICLE PARKING ON
TOWNSHIP ROADS, STREETS, AND HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, a traffic and roadway safety issue exists in Elyria Township due to the parking of semi-truck vehicles upon Township roads, streets and highways;

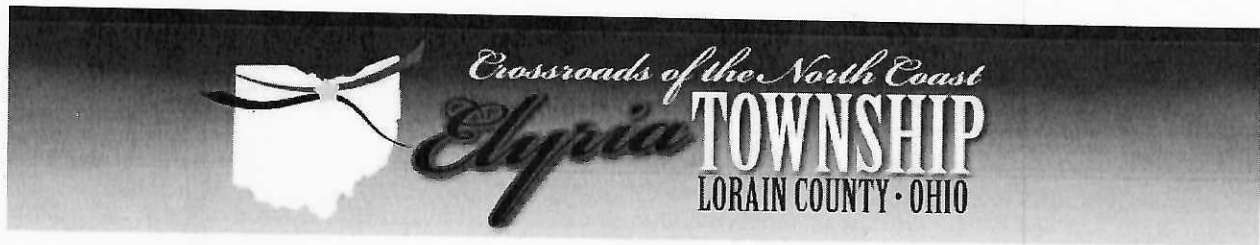
WHEREAS, R.C. 505.17 authorizes a township to issue regulations and orders as are necessary to address vehicle parking within a township and upon township roads, streets and highways;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees find it necessary to regulate parking of semi-truck vehicles on any township road, street, or highway in the unincorporated areas of Elyria Township;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the **Board of Trustees of Elyria Township**, Lorain County, Ohio, that no person shall cause or permit to stand, park or permit to be parked, any semi-truck vehicle, which consists of any of the following as defined by R.C. 4501.01: (1) a vehicle, tractor unit, or commercial tractor unit or (2) a vehicle, tractor unit, or commercial tractor unit, and one or more semitrailers, or (3) a semitrailer unit, on any township road, street, or highway in the unincorporated areas of Elyria Township except when continuously and actively engaged in the process of loading or unloading goods from such vehicle or semitrailer unit, or when being used to perform a service for the day and will be removed at the end of the day;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any violation of this regulatory resolution prohibiting the parking of a semi-truck vehicle, as described and defined above, on any Elyria Township road, street or highway in the unincorporated areas of Elyria Township shall be a minor misdemeanor criminal offense, and fines collected from such a violation shall be paid into the Township general fund;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this regulation shall have an **effective date of March 13, 2023**, and shall be posted by the Township Fiscal Officer in five conspicuous public places in the Township for 30 days before becoming effective, and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township for three consecutive weeks in accordance in R.C. 505.17.
